

# GETTING STARTED WITH CANVA

First, you need to create a free Canva account. Canva has a free and pro version to choose from. The free version is great for beginners and all you need to edit my templates.



**GET CANVA**



Click on the link above to log into your account or create a new one.

head to Canva and click on 'Sign up for free' on the homepage to begin the registration process.

# YOUR WORKSPACE

Mastering the toolbar is essential for editing your project, providing quick access to tools that help refine and perfect your design, ensuring it's polished and cohesive.



- 1 Position - Arrange layers or align text, elements and photos in your design
- 2 Transparency - adjust the transparency of text, elements or photos in your design
- 3 Copy and paste styles in your design
- 4 Lock text and unlock elements, or photos in your design to stop them from moving
- 5 Download your design, share a view-only or editable link, invite collaborators and more.

# YOUR TOOLS AND WORKSPACE

The Edit toolbar in Canva appears when you select an image. It provides options to adjust the element, such as cropping, flipping, or applying filters, depending on the type of element selected.





## UPLOADING YOUR OWN PHOTOS




### Uploading photos and videos to Canva is easy!

- Tap or click the uploads icon
- Then select 'UPLOAD FILES'
- Locate the files you want to upload and select ADD
- Then click the uploaded files to add to your design

You can also drag and drop photos directly from your device into Canva

### Tip!


No ancestor photo? Consider using a silhouette in your family tree to keep the design uniform. Need some? Message me on Etsy, and I'll send complimentary silhouettes your way!



Canva also has a HUGE library of photos you can use in your designs, like old clocks or watches to represent the passage of time, or a state flag or flower to symbolize where someone came from.


Photo grids are a great tool that will help you create a clean aesthetic to your design for a professional look



# PHOTO FRAMES

Frames allow you to ADD or CROP images and videos into the shape of the selected frame



Canva has lots of different shape and style frames to choose from, including basic shapes aswell as phone and laptop mockups




## TO ADD A BLANK FRAME

**You can do the same with video!**


# EDITING TOOLS

## 1. Spacing

THE SPACING TOOL ALLOWS YOU TO ADD OR REMOVE SPACING BETWEEN TEXT AND LINES.




SELECT THE TEXT YOU WANT TO EDIT. THEN MOVE THE SLIDERS LEFT OR RIGHT TO INCREASE OR DECREASE SPACING.

## 2. Effects

EFFECTS ALLOW YOU TO ADD A LITTLE FLARE TO YOUR TEXT.



IN THIS EXAMPLE I USED THE ECHO EFFECT. THERE ARE MULTIPLE OPTIONS FOR TEXT EFFECTS AND MULTIPLE OPTIONS TO CUSTOMIZE THEM AS WELL. I LOVE THIS FEATURE TO ADD A LITTLE POP TO MY DESIGNS.



## 3. Animate



ANIMATE IS A FEATURE THAT ALLOWS YOU TO ANIMATE TEXT, PHOTOS, ELEMENTS, AND EVEN YOUR ENTIRE PAGE.



THERE ARE MANY OPTIONS TO CHOOSE FROM. TO USE, SELECT THE TEXT, ELEMENT, OR PHOTO YOU WANT TO ANIMATE - SELECT ANIMATE - THEN SELECT ANIMATION OF YOUR CHOICE.

## 4. Transparency



Transparency CHANGES THE OPACITY OF A DESIGN ELEMENT. THIS FEATURE can be applied to images, elements, AND text.



SELECT THE DESIGN ELEMENT THEN SELECT CHECKERED ICON AND MOVE THE SLIDER TO ADJUST TRANSPARENCY.

# POSITION TOOL & LAYERS


Use the Position tool to move elements, photos, text boxes, or videos within your design. Each item on the page has its own layer, which you can bring forward or send backward to create the desired arrangement. Access the Position toolbar to adjust and organize these layers easily.



## TO MOVE THE CIRCLE TO THE BACK

Click on 'POSITION' and tap on 'BACKWARD' to move it behind the layer.

You could also move up and down from the layers panel to re-order



Select the element you want to align or space evenly. In the toolbar, click on the alignment options (e.g., center, top, bottom, left, or right) to snap the element into place relative to the page.

To distribute multiple elements evenly, use the Space Evenly option for a clean and balanced design.


# LOCKING DESIGN ELEMENTS



Locking design elements is a great way to keep your design organized and ensure parts of your design stay in place, preventing accidental movement while working on other elements, and it gives you collaborative design control when working on shared designs, locking elements prevents collaborators from unintentionally modifying or moving critical components.

**TO LOCK A DESIGN ELEMENT**  
Simply select the item you want to lock into place and select the LOCK icon

**TO UNLOCK A DESIGN ELEMENT**  
Select the item you want to unlock and select the LOCK icon again

If your screen is low on space it will hide some of these tools. Just click the 3 dots to find them



# ADDING HYPERLINKS


Link text, images, or buttons to websites, documents, or other pages in your project! Perfect for creating interactive Family History Books or Genealogy Planners, making it easy to navigate through generations.

## TO ADD A WEBSITE LINK TO THIS BUTTON ABOVE

Right click on the element and choose 'LINK' from the dropdown and enter the website in the box - hit 'ENTER' or 'DONE'



**NOTE** - You can also link text or elements to another page of your design! Instead of adding a website, scroll down and select the page you want to link to. Just make sure to name your pages first for easy navigation!

## TO ADD A LINK TO TEXT IN A PARAGRAPH

# USING AI TO WRITE STORIES

## WRITING YOUR ANCESTORS' STORY

Before you begin, collect as much information as possible about your ancestors. This can include birth and death dates, locations, occupations, family relationships, and any anecdotes or stories you may have heard from older relatives.

### BE SPECIFIC:

Provide clear and detailed prompts. Explain that you're writing a family history book and need help creating narratives or stories based on your ancestral information.

### TIPS FOR USING CHAT GPT

Don't be afraid to ask follow-up questions or refine your prompts to get the best results.

AI can be a powerful tool, you will need to edit to your liking.

## PROVIDE CONTEXT

Share relevant background details to help ChatGPT better understand your request, resulting in more accurate and meaningful responses.

## USE MULTIPLE PROMPTS

For longer or more detailed stories, break the narrative into smaller prompts, building upon each to create a cohesive story.

## SPECIFY THE STYLE


Mention the style or tone you want for the story. For example, you can ask for a historical account, a creative narrative, or a formal report.

### Use Creative Prompts:

If you want a creative or imaginative story, don't hesitate to use prompts that encourage creativity. Examples :  
"Create a narrative about my ancestor John Smith, born in 1850 in New York, who was a farmer and raised a family of six."

# SAVING AND SHARING YOUR PROJECTS

Canva auto-saves your designs in the app as you edit!



## TO SAVE YOUR DESIGN TO YOUR DEVICE OR TO SHARE

There are a few different ways depending on the format you need

### 1 CLICK THE SHARE BUTTON

On top right

Not to be used for collaboration

### 2 TEMPLATE LINK

Use this option if you want to create a link to your template where any user can edit the design - this will not change your original

### 3 CHOOSE DOWNLOAD

Choose Download to save your design to your device. Canva will suggest the best format based on your content, but you can adjust it as needed.

### 4 PEOPLE WITH ACCESS

Click Share, enter their email under 'People with access', set permissions, and click Send.

- Can edit (to allow them to make changes)
- Can view (to let them only view the design)


## Tips for Professional and Home Printing

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRINTING

1. Click Share, then select Download.
2. Choose PDF Print for high-quality output that ensures consistent display across devices.
3. Enable Crop Marks and Bleed if using a professional printing service. If printing at home you will not need to select that.
4. FLATTEN: Merges all layers to prevent editing discrepancies
5. For Pro Accounts: Switch to CMYK color for accurate printing.
6. For Free Accounts: Ensure your design uses RGB color.


## Instructions for Sharing Your Canva Project Digitally

1. Share: In the top-right corner of your Canva design, click download.
2. Choose PDF Standard for digital sharing, as it provides a smaller file size ideal for online use.
3. Select the number of pages you want to print
4. Ensure RGB Color: Canva uses RGB color mode for digital designs and then click download to your device.
5. Share the File: Send the file via email, messaging apps, or upload it to cloud storage (e.g., Google Drive, Dropbox) and share the link.

### Create the Flipbook:

- Use an online flipbook platform (e.g., FlipHTML5, Issuu, or FlippingBook) (Requires a subscription.)







## TO RESIZE YOUR DESIGN IN SECONDS

COPY & RESIZE will create a new design


RESIZE will change the current design and you will need to adjust the elements.



Select your photo and choose 'EDIT PHOTO' then tap the 'BACKGROUND REMOVER'

## DESIGN TIP

To add depth, place text behind an image. In Pic 2, I duplicated the photo, used Background Remover and added a different background, added text between the layers, and applied a glow effect for emphasis.





# MAGIC ERASER





## TIDY YOUR IMAGES AND REMOVE UNWANTED PARTS EASILY

Select your photo and choose 'EDIT PHOTO' then tap the 'MAGIC ERASER'. Then use the brush to draw over the parts you want to be removed

Easily remove unwanted marks on an image or design with precision, giving you complete control to refine your project.




# MAGIC EXPAND



## QUICKLY EXTEND THE BACKGROUND OF AN IMAGE

If you have an image that cuts off, use the Magic expand tool and it will extend your background!



Choose 1:1 or whole page

# MAGIC EDIT



## CHANGE ANY ELEMENTS OF A PHOTO IN SECONDS

Select the image, choose 'EDIT PHOTO' and tap the Magic Edit tool



Choose your brush size and draw over the parts of the photo you want to change then describe what you want to change it to

# MAGIC GRAB



**GRAB SOMETHING FROM A PHOTO AND MOVE IT AWAY FROM BACKGROUND**

Select the image, choose 'EDIT PHOTO' and tap the Magic Grab tool



Simply select the object you want to grab and drag it off!



Magic Grab makes it easy to reposition or isolate elements without disrupting your design.



# GRAB TEXT



## CHANGE THE TEXT FROM A POSTER OR IMAGE

Select the image, choose 'EDIT PHOTO' and tap the Grab Text tool

Select the text you want to change and either change the font or type something new



This tool allows you instantly extract text from images, making it easy to reuse or edit
